Language and communication groups are carried out in different ways depending on the needs of your child. Published schemes include **Wellcom**; WellComm is a speech and language toolkit for screening and intervention in the early years. It enables early years practitioners to regularly profile children's speech and language and to identify children at risk of developing delayed communication skills. The link Speech Therapist also develops individual programmes for specific children which are then carried out by a member of staff. **Talk Boost** is another language and communication programme we use in Reception and year 1.

Catch Up Literacy is a programme to support children's reading.

Units of Sound and Nessy are online programmes to support children with specific literacy difficulties including dyslexia.

Phonic Awareness Training (PAT) is a programme to support children's ability to read and write rhyming words.

5 minute Maths Box is a resource to support basic number skills.

Dynamo maths is an online programme to support basic number skills

Volunteer Readers are parents and people from the community who read weekly with children who need extra support.

Beanstalk is a charity that provides volunteers to support with reading twice a week for 30 minutes.

The Art Room is a weekly support for children with emotional and social needs and takes place at Robert Blair Primary School.

Learning Mentoring is a weekly session with a Teaching Assistant to help support with social and emotional issues.

Circle of Friends is a weekly peer support group to help develop friendships within the class.

Secondary Transition Groups are run to help children prepare for secondary transfer.
